The story of the journey to Emmaus is one of my favorite parts of the Easter story. Jesus, who only hours earlier rose from the dead, decided to surprise

Cleopas and his friend as they walked from Jerusalem to Emmaus. Just think about it: The risen Christ decided to go for a walk.

I can only imagine the merriment in Jesus' heart as he overheard the conversation between his two disciples. ### **Greek Editor Visits Nashville!**


